A **MINIMUM** allowance of <u>\$2.50</u> per week is required.

Children should be able to earn additional moneys by doing extra chores or for rewards. It can be earned through behavior contracts or through special work assignments. It is recommended that children save a portion of all moneys that are earned. Allowances are a *required* part of foster care. The purpose of allowance is to teach the child the value of working and complying with requirements of a household. **Allowances should be given weekly**. Allowance is to be paid from your monthly reimbursement.

The following is recommended If chores are completed and behavior is good.

4 & under--\$10.00 per month5 to 8--\$16.00 per month9 to 11--\$20.00 per month12 to 14--\$32.00 per month15 to 18--\$48.00 per month

- Foster parents can collect up to twenty-five percent (25%) of any allowance above the minimum for restitution. i.e. damages and phone calls <u>as approved</u> <u>by Case Manager</u>.
- NOTE: No restitution can be withheld if the <u>minimum</u> amount of \$2.50 allowance (per week) is given.
